A translation table is available for institutions to translate their institutional major or program codes to the common code. 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- A new valid value code of ZITC – Initial Teacher Certification will be collected for the Regents Academic Interest Code (SPE015) data element.
- ZITC will help institutions code and track students enrolled in programs that lead to teacher certifications.
- Business Practices updated to include the purpose of the Initial Teacher Certification Code (ZITC)



# Required Translation: Regents Academic Interest Code

## ZITC – Initial Teacher Certification

- Institutions will determine how to identify students enrolled in programs that lead to teacher certification
  - Institutional Major Code with Field of Study Category as:
    - Major
    - Minor
    - Concentration (New ‘ZITC’ Concentration Code)
  - Institutional Program Code

**Institutional Banner value must be translated to ‘ZITC’ on SOAXREF-RGTACIN**

Translated Institutional Program Code

# External Site Code (SEC009)

- The Validation Rule VSEC004 for External Site Code (SEC009) has been updated to ensure that the external site is valid and within range for the specific school.
- Validation Rule VSEC004: If External Site code is not null or "NONFIR", then it should be a valid code in approved list for the institution.

# Instructional Delivery Code (SECo25)

## Validation Rule:

**VSEC036** – Instructional Delivery Code must be a valid value or NULL

## Updated Descriptions of Valid Values

Code	Description
F	Fully at a distance - All instruction is delivered via technology. The course does not require students to travel to a classroom for instruction; however, it might require students to travel to a site to attend a course orientation or to take exams. (NOTE: This is generally equivalent to delivering more than 95 percent of sessions via technology.)
P	Predominately at a distance – Technology is used to deliver 51 percent or more of scheduled class sessions, but at least one visit to a classroom (or similar site) for instruction is required.
H	At most HALF at a distance - Technology is used to deliver 50 percent or less of scheduled class sessions, but at least one class session is replaced by technology.

**NOTE:** A null value will equate to Technology Enhanced In Person courses.
