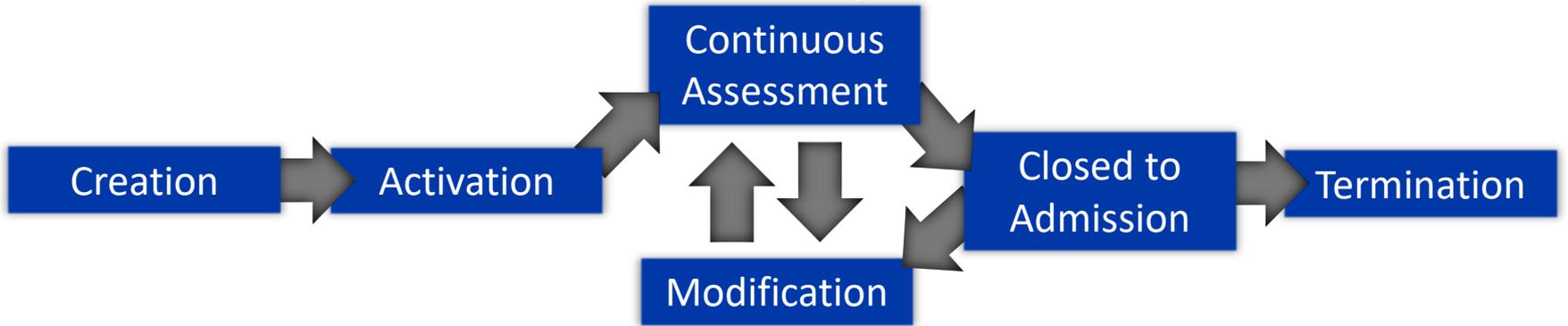

Lifecycle of an Academic Program & Corresponding CAAP Statuses



Effective Terms for Activation and Terminations

- Authorized, Not Yet Active
 - Are you ready to add to admissions application and/or change of major forms?
 - Has a webpage been created (perhaps not fully developed, but live)?
 - If both = YES, submit request!
- Termination:
 - Are there ZERO students enrolled?
 - Are you passed the readmit window for any previously enrolled students?
 - If both = YES, submit request!
 - If only the first is YES but you have a plan for any students who may re-enroll to change their major, you can submit the request.



Effective Terms for Deactivations: Always a future term!

IDEAL SEQUENCING

1. Check if admissions application or change of major form is open for the proposed effective term.
(Answer = No)
2. Submit Request to USG.
3. If USG approved, Submit Request to SACSCOC.
4. Remove from admissions application and/or change of major form when applicable.

From SACSCOC substantive change Policy and Procedures Manual:

Because closure approval is approval of the teach-out process, not the closure per se (i.e., not after the fact), a teach-out plan should be submitted as soon as possible after the decision is made to close.

No decision is made formally made until USG has approved.



Effective Terms for Deactivations: Always a future term!

IDEAL SEQUENCING

1. Check if admissions application or change of major form is open for the proposed effective term.
(Answer = No)
2. Submit Request to USG.
3. If USG approved, Submit Request to SACSCOC.
4. Remove from admissions application and/or change of major form when applicable.

IN OTHER CASES...

1. Check if admissions application or change of major form is open for the proposed effective term.
(Answer = YES)
2. Remove from admissions application and/or change of major form.
3. Submit Request to USG.
4. If denied (postponed), undo #2.
5. If USG approved, Submit Request to SACSCOC.



GDP versus CAAP

- Georgia Degrees Pay Program Search
 - Only shows active programs without certain attributes
 - E.g., no “fall-back masters”
- Catalog of Authorized Academic Programs
 - Shows all programs(active only filter can be adjusted)

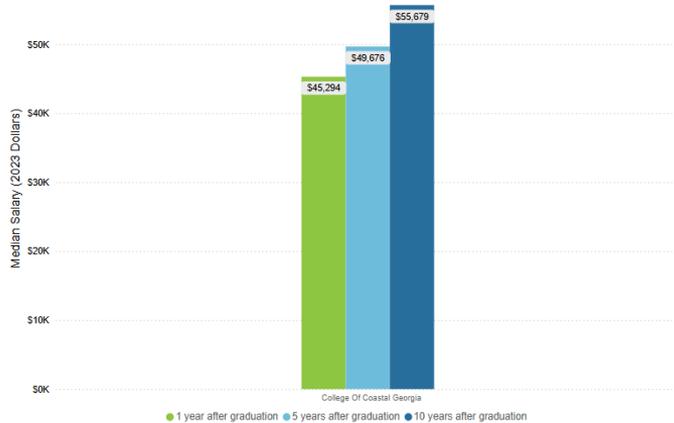

Median Salary for Graduates Working in Georgia

The median salary for graduates completing a bachelor program in Junior High/Intermediate/Middle School Education and Teaching from College Of Coastal Georgia is \$45,294 one year after graduation, \$49,676 five years after graduation, and \$55,679 ten years after graduation.

- Counseling = Done! State Law requires 60cr.
- Education = Only certain programs
 - Elementary/Special Ed Dual Certification
 - Middle Grades Education (Done = RAC recommended 120)

 - Bachelors > 120
 - Masters > 36
 - Non-Health Associates > 60
 - Health Associates >70

Require programs report to whomever will lead this effort at your institution as to whether they will be modifying curriculum or submitting a waiver request	Feb 3, 2025	April 3, 2025
Require programs take action to submit curriculum proposals or to submit the waiver requests through institutional channels	May 1, 2025	Oct 1, 2025

Classifying Off-Campus Instructional Sites

(SACSCOC) Off-Campus Instructional Sites

Physical locations geographically *apart* from an institution's main campus, where instruction is delivered and student(s) are required to be there to receive instruction

Online

Institutional Sites

- Included in the facilities inventory
- Typically, owned or exclusively occupied
- Same database used in funding formula for state appropriations (i.e., "M&O" - Maintenance & Operations)

External Sites

- NOT included in the facilities inventory
- Typically, are spaces occupied non-exclusively, contractual, have a nominal cost, and/or are temporary

What counts/gets reported?

Non-Examples

The institution offers instruction at a location, but students can only participate virtually from elsewhere

Clinical/Internship Locations (this is not traditional instruction)

Conference Locations (this is not instruction, unless it is formally part of an institution's continuing education program offerings and the institution is providing instruction)

Exchange Program sites (instruction is not being provided by the USG institution but rather by the cooperating institution)

What's the threshold for reporting?

Notification: If at least...

- USG: ...50% of the instruction in a COURSE occurs at that site.
- SACSCOC: ... 25% of the instruction in a PROGRAM occurs at that site.

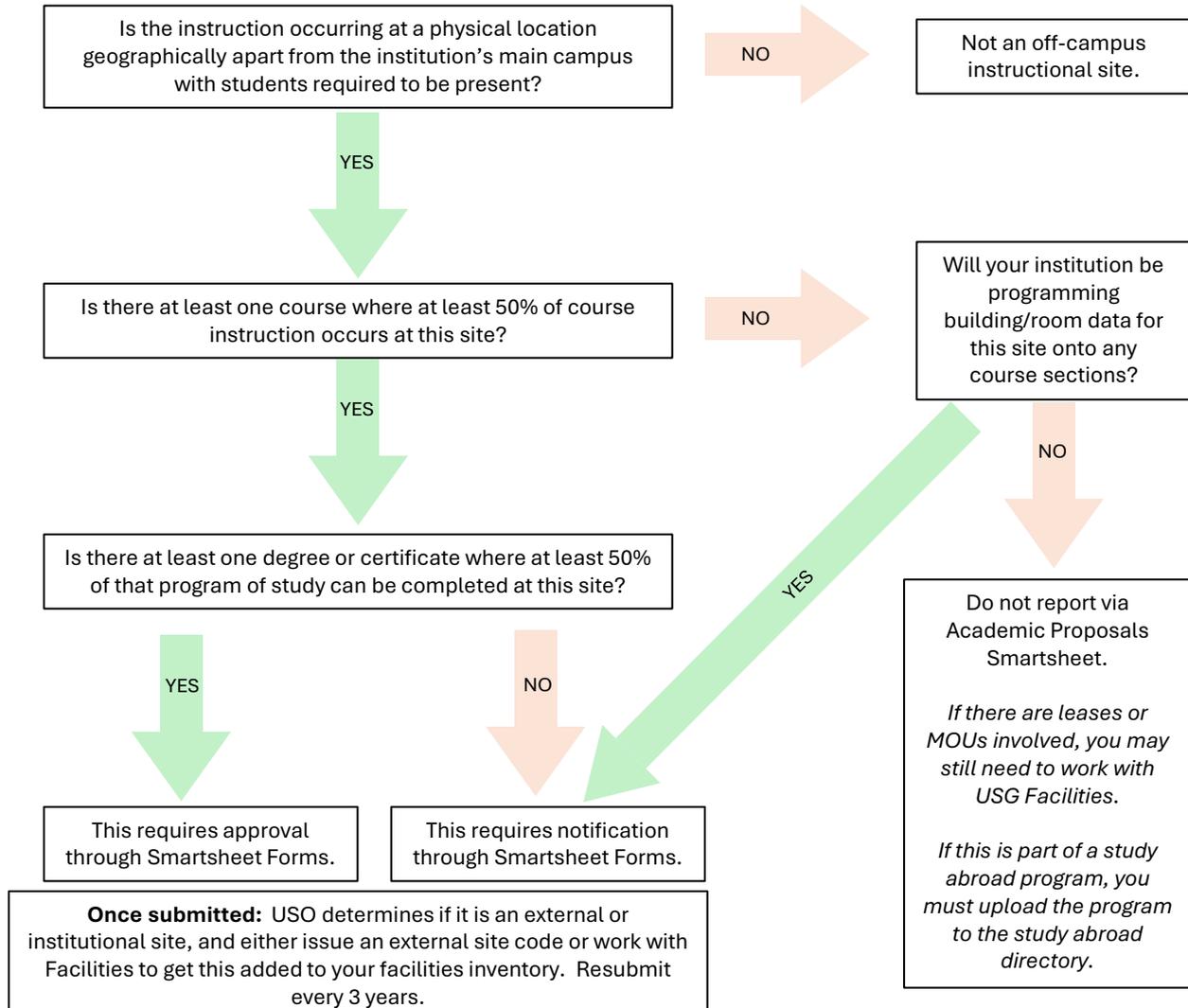
Approval: If at least....

- USG & SACSCOC: ... 50% of the instruction in a PROGRAM occurs at that site.

Study Abroad:

- SITES: The above holds for reporting study abroad locations as well.
- PROGRAMS: All must be submitted to the Study Abroad Directory regardless of where the courses are taught.

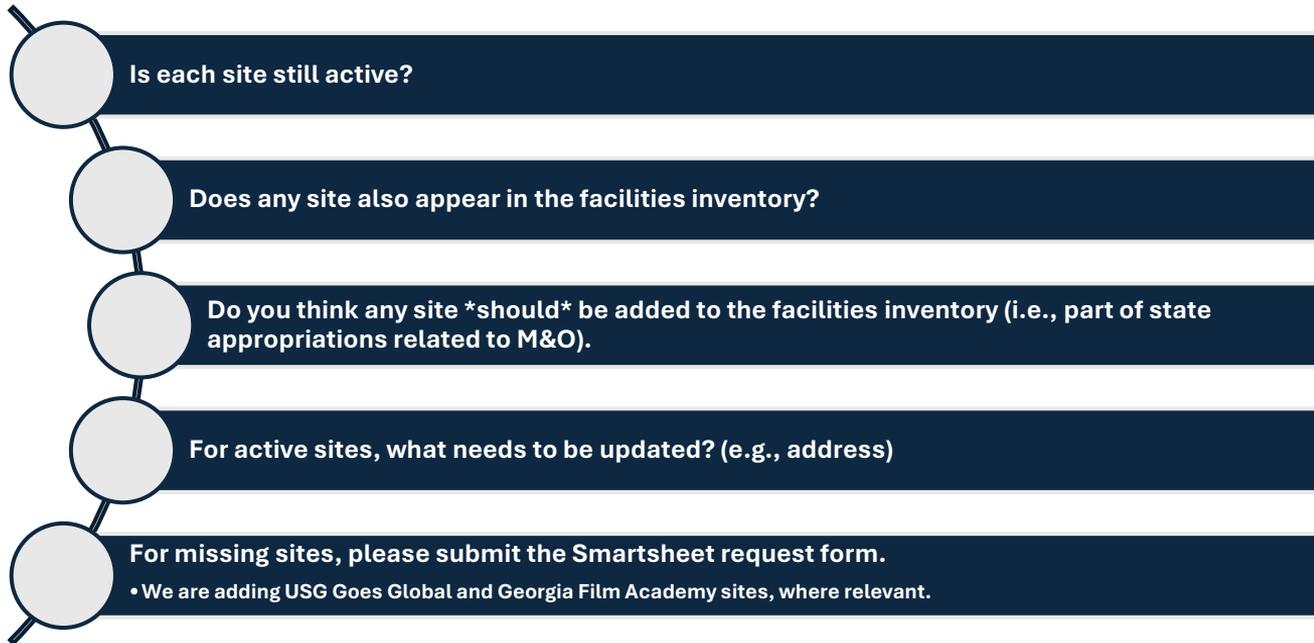
