Updates from System Office- Dr. Joyce Jones

- The planning for distributing a vaccine for Covid 19 is in the works for when it becomes available. Every campus has been invited to discuss the distribution of the vaccine before it becomes available. Individuals with questions should reach out to their Director of Public Health Center or to the Vice President of Student Affairs at their institution.
- Most institutions have decided whether their graduation will be virtual or in person. Final decisions should be posted online so that students are aware of institutions decisions for Fall 2020 Commencement.
- There are students that have tested positive more than once for Covid 19. Please read CDC Guidelines about repeated positive test of Covid 19. Also, speak with Health Directors about repeated Covid 19 positive test.
- Currently there is no system wide Multicultural Group that exist. Sometimes staff in Human Resources or the Chief Diversity Officer manages the Multicultural Group. Recommendation: Maybe a subgroup from RAC-SL can be created.
- Nadirah started to research the need and creation of a system wide Multicultural Group during the Summer 2020.
