- AI-enhanced admissions communication launched in 2016 at GSU and now using it for retention, too
- Provide guiding principles for AI use to students during admissions process: Tech
- Element451, CRM, uses AI for all student communication, Chatbot: ABAC
- Use AI to free up time for staff to handle interactions that need human interaction, to prompt students to submit documents, in classes with high D/F grades: reminders, responds to questions like "I need

directions for this assignment” (profound effect on final grades in these classes), speed up current processes for better student service (Parchment Raptor for transcript evaluation)

- Key for successful results: effort into monitoring and managing AI features, ensure you know what problem you are trying to solve
- What’s next? Using AI in advising to help students walk through the advising process

### **Procedure on Preferred Names within USG Systems of Record**

- Dr. Todd Watson, Associate Vice Chancellor, Chief Information Security Officer, USG
- Sarah Wenham, Director, Student Enrollment Services, USG
- Goal: consistent identity management and fraud protection
- Systems of record: authoritative data source SIS, HRIS, and ID Mgmt platforms
- Institution responsible to confirm that legal name is supported by official government document, reviewed, and approved
- What if a student is not verified by end of add/drop? They should be dropped. Institutions can determine if they want to place a proactive hold to identify and notify unverified students and if they want to offer a grace period for reinstatement.
- Questions about what name is on ISIR and verification (Sue vs Susan example)
- Concern expressed about using legal name on rosters, etc. for students whose identity is connected to their preferred name
- Guidance not yet available on how institutions can indicate a name has been verified

- IMPACTS: reach out with questions, USG ASH has been updated to reflect Core IMPACTS
- LS changes: HS GPA becoming more reliable again & new analysis; FA26: updated HS GPA thresholds for exemption in place (can be rolled out earlier); new placement mechanisms allowed with approval and a data analysis plan
- TCSG Course Articulations: Gen Ed course list expanded from 28 to 38 starting FA25
- Gen Ed Council and RAC: streamlining course approval process, major analysis of Field of Study
- Volunteers for Transfer Improvement project requested, update to private institution list for citizenship requirements, FA 25 next round for STEM bump, ACM review coming

### **Georgia Degrees Pay & the Catalog of Authorized Academic Programs**

Dr. Laura Lynch, Associate Vice Chancellor, Academic Programs & Policy, USG

- DMA (Degrees and Majors Authorized) now CAAP (Catalog of Authorized Academic Programs) and interface was updated
- Life cycle of program: Creation, Activation, Continuous Assessment, Modification, Closed to Admission, Termination
- Corresponding CAPP statuses: Authorized, Not Yet Active, Active, Deactivated, Terminated (no status corresponding to Continuous Assessment/Modification)

- Authorized, Not Yet Active should be changed once campus is ready to add to admissions app and program webpage is created
- Termination should be selected once there are zero students in the program and readmit window has passed (or if there is a plan to enroll readmits into another program)
- Deactivation term: admissions app and change of major form should not be open for the proposed effective term of deactivation before submitting to USG
- GDP only shows active programs
