Financial Aid Data Collection (FADC) 25-26 Aid Year

Key Dates

- **October 08, 2026** – Collection opens
- **October 15, 2026** – Deadline for an initial extraction
- **November 06, 2026** – Extraction and Certification Form Due Date

Certification Forms must be submitted by close of business (5:00 PM) on November 6.

Institution Pre-requisites for FADC

Prior to extracting:

- Run the Banner FISAP Report for the 2025 – 2026 Aid Year (RORFS26)
- Install FADC version 1.6 (FADC_DDL.sql)

Changes Included in the FADC 25-26 Aid Year

Financial Aid Data Collection

- Increase to HOPE and HOPECT Maximum Award Amounts
- New and Updated Data Elements related to Adjusted Gross Income (AGI)
- Updates to FADC Trend Reports

HOPE and HOPECT Maximum Award Amounts

- Updates based on changes in State and Federal Aid programs.
 - HOPE: Maximum Award Amount increased from \$15,400 to \$16,000
 - HOPECT: Maximum Award Amount increased from \$15,400 to \$16,000

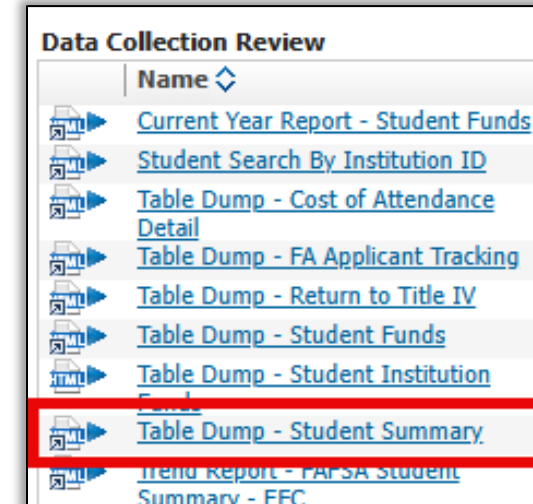

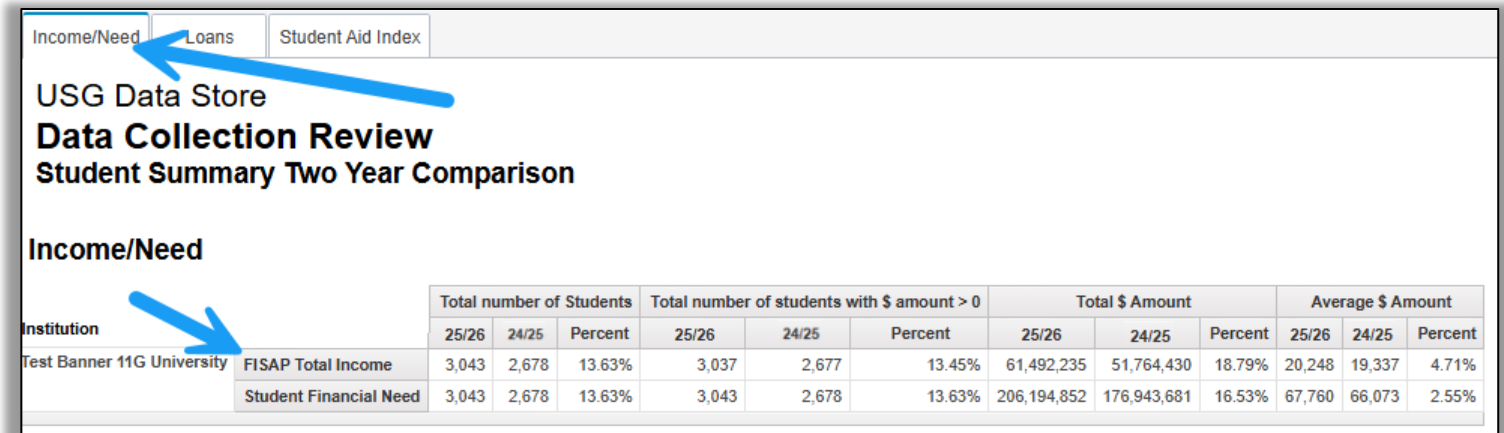
