Summer Mid-Term 20271 Collection Dates

Preliminary Headcount

- **June 04, 2026** – Collection opens for Preliminary Headcount
- **June 10, 2026** – Deadline for an initial extraction
- **June 12, 2026** – Required Extraction for Preliminary Headcount

All institutions must run ZADMETL and **extract on**
June 12 before 5:00 PM. The collection closes
for persistence of PH data at 5:00 PM



Summer Mid-Term 20271 Collection Dates

Key Mid-Term Dates

- **June 18, 2026** – Collection Re-Opens
- **July 08, 2026** – Summer MT ADC Census Date
- **July 15, 2026** – Extraction and Certification Form Due Date

Certification Forms must be submitted by close of business (5:00 PM) on July 15.

- **Fee Classification Code (SWC001):** NEW waiver code for Federal Service Employees
- **Student Attribute Code (STE074):** NEW military student attributes associated with Space Force
- **Advanced Standing Code (STE085):** NEW valid values and elements created



Fee Classification Code (SWC001)

Updates to Fee Classification Code (Tuition and Fee Waivers) (SWC001):

- A new fee classification waiver code for Federal Service to track students who qualify through military or federal service under 20 U.S. Code § 1015d

Fee Classification Waiver Code for Federal Service Employees

Code: WFED

Description: Federal Service – Member, Spouse, Dep Child

Category: Waiver



Fee Class Code: Banner Practice & Data Collection

Banner Practice

- Review the Detail Code Control Form – Student (TSADETC)
- If needed, create a new detail code for charges or payments for Federal Service
- Translate institutional codes for Federal Services to the USG Electronic Value 'WFED' under the EDI Cross-Reference Rules (SOAXREF) using the cross-reference label RGTDETC – Waiver Detail Code.
- Fee Classification data is entered and collected from the Student Account Detail Review Form (TSAAREV)

Data Collection

- Fee Classification data is included in the Cognos Student Fee Classification table dump and Fee Classification Summary reports and is stored in the ODS and PDC ADMSTU_FEE_CLASS_MIMIC tables.

Student Attribute Code (STE074)

Updates to Student Attribute Code (STE074):

- New valid values for military student attributes associated with the Space Force

Code: MAS	Code: RAS
Description: Military Active Space Force	Description: Dependent/Spouse Active Space Force
Category: Admissions – Military	Category: Admissions – Military
- The collection logic will pull student attribute codes for the student's most current accepted application.

Student Attributes: Banner Practice & Data Collection

Banner Practice

- Review the Student Attribute Validation (STVATTS) and add the new attribute codes for Space Force (MAS & RAS)
- Translate existing institutional attribute codes for Active Space Force to the USG Electronic Values MAS and RAS under the EDI Cross-Reference Rules (SOAXREF) using the cross-reference label RGTATTS
- Student Attributes are entered and collected from Additional Student Information (SGASADD)

Data Collection

- Student Attributes are included in the Cognos Student Attributes table dump and Summary reports and are stored in the ODS and PDC ADMSTU_ATTRIBUTESS_MIMIC tables.

Advanced Standing Code (STE085)

Updates to Advanced Standing Code (STE085):

- New Valid Values
 - 9999SF – ACE Military Credit: Space Force
 - 999942 – Credit by Other Examination
 - 999943 – CAIE (Cambridge Advanced International Education)
- Updated Validation Rule to include new values
 - VSTE265: Advanced Standing Codes can only be 999901, 999902, 999903, 999904, 999905, 999906, 999908, 999909, 999910, 9999AF, 9999AR, 9999CG, 9999DD, 9999MC, 9999NA, 999941, **9999SF, 999942, 999943**.

New Advanced Standing Hours Data Elements

Advanced Standing Hours – ACE Military Credit: Space Force (STE117)

- Credit hours accepted through Space Force courses from military transcripts or course credit given for active-duty assignments through ACE.
 - *9999SF – ACE Military Credit: Space Force*

Advanced Standing Hours – Credit by Other Examination (STE118)

- Credit hours accepted through other examinations, such as departmental exams, FLATS, ACTFL, etc.
 - *999942 – Credit by Other Examination*

Advanced Standing Hours – CAIE (Cambridge Advanced International Education) (STE119)

- Credit hours accepted through the Cambridge International Education for Advanced A and AS curriculum levels
 - *999943 – CAIE (Cambridge Advanced International Education)*

Adv. Standing : Banner Practice & Data Collection

Banner Practice

- Non-standard SBGI codes for advanced standing must be translated on SOAXREF-RGTADPL
- Entered in Banner on the Transfer Articulation Evaluation page (SHATAEQ) as transfer credit

Data Collection

- Collected from SHATRNS based on the credit earned in SHATAEQ
- Stored in the ODS and PDC ADMSTU_ADV_STANDING_MIMIC tables
- Included in the Cognos Advanced Standing Summary report and the Student Advanced Standing table dump reports

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Academic Data Collection (ADC)

The Academic Data Collection (ADC) collects student information, including course enrollment, graduation, course and schedule information, and other academic data. Institutions submit data at least twice each term, once at midterm and again at the end of term, according to the published [ADC Due Dates Calendar](#).

The **Transfer Course Collection**, introduced in Summer 2021, captures transfer data for recently matriculated students enrolled in ENGL, MATH, and STAT courses at the 1000 or 2000 level. This supports the Momentum Approach efforts that occurs each July during the Summer ADC.
