ADC Spring Mid-Term

- New High Impact Practice (HIP) Course Section Attribute (SEC028)
 - Diversity/Global Learning Primary and Context attributes
- Reintroduce validation VSES014 as a known issue (If Section Location code is A or D and External Site is null and room code is not null then the building/room combination must be in the Facilities Master File)

FIDC Spring

- Modification and reactivation of VBRM007 (Room Use Code 110 requires square feet per station between 1 and 40).

- III. Update to Upcoming Collections

ADC Summer Mid-Term

- Changing validation VSPE016 (If M is submitted for Degree Level Code, then the Student Level must be 72) to fire only for majors, not concentrations.
- Fixing an ETL issue with Course Section Technology that can cause failure
- Adding STU_INST_UID to display in Cognos for VSTE221 (State of Origin must be a valid code except for citizenship status codes of A) to ease identifying students
- Adding validation to prevent graduate level students from receiving Border State Waivers per policy
- Remediation for error VSTE011 [If matriculation date is \geq than 20031, then if Admit Type is "FR" for Traditional Freshman (but High School Code does not equal "NNNNNN" and High School Diploma Type does not equal "HS" or "GD"), the High School GPA cannot be null] to properly account for null HS diploma type.
