2. Why is the new element needed?

The Classic Learning Test (CLT) is an online college entrance exam for 11th and 12th graders. In the February 2026 Board meeting, Policy 04.02.01 Admission Requirements for Programs Leading to an Associate or Baccalaureate Degree was revised to require all institutions, except UGA and GT, to accept CLT scores beginning with Fall 2027 admission. The revised policy states that CLT scores shall be substituted for SAT scores based on the CLT-SAT concordance tables and converted scores shall be used with the SAT Freshman Index (FI) formula when an FI is needed.

3. When is the new element needed? Please list the first term you are asking the element to be collected, as well as the latest acceptable term collection could start. Also note if there are any policies or deadlines related to your request.

As soon as possible but no later than MT Collection Fall 2027. The test can be used for admissions in Fall 2027, but institutions can enter CLT test scores earlier than that to allow for analysis.

- *The CLT Verbal Reasoning score must be between 0-40 if not null. Excludes Admit Type TR, TL, TP, NT, TN, AU, and PB.*
- *The CLT Grammar/Writing score must be between 0-40 if not null. Excludes Admit Type TR, TL, TP, NT, TN, AU, and PB.*
- *The CLT Quantitative Reasoning score must be between 0-40 if not null. Excludes Admit Type TR, TL, TP, NT, TN, AU, and PB.*
- *If a test score is submitted for CLT Total Test Score, CLT Verbal Reasoning, CLT Grammar/Writing, or CLT Quantitative Reasoning, then a test score for all 4 CLT Test Codes must be present.*
