

New Classic Learning Test Codes for Fall 2026 End-of-Term Collection

Beginning with the Fall 2026 End-of-Term (EOT) 20272 Academic Data Collection, new Classic Learning Test (CLT) test codes will be available to institutions to support revisions to *Policy 04.02.01 Admission Requirements for Programs Leading to an Associate or Baccalaureate Degree* which requires all institutions, except the University of Georgia and Georgia Institute of Technology, to accept CLT scores beginning with Fall 2027 admission. While the test cannot be used for admissions until Fall 2027, institutions should enter CLT test scores earlier than that to allow for analysis.

Five new test codes will be created and collected as part of the Academic Data Collection.

<i>CLT4</i>	<i>CLT Quantitative Reasoning</i>	<i>0-40</i>
<i>CLT5</i>	<i>CLT Verbal Reasoning + Grammar/Writing</i>	<i>0-80</i>

The following validations will be utilized to ensure data quality:

- The CLT Total score must be between 0-120 if not null. Excludes Admit Type TR, TL, TP, NT, TN, AU, and PB.
- The CLT Verbal Reasoning score must be between 0-40 if not null. Excludes Admit Type TR, TL, TP, NT, TN, AU, and PB.
- The CLT Grammar/Writing score must be between 0-40 if not null. Excludes Admit Type TR, TL, TP, NT, TN, AU, and PB.
- The CLT Quantitative Reasoning score must be between 0-40 if not null. Excludes Admit Type TR, TL, TP, NT, TN, AU, and PB.
- The CLT Verbal Reasoning + Grammar/Writing score must be between 0-80 if not null. Excludes Admit Type TR, TL, TP, NT, TN, AU, and PB.
- If a test score is submitted for CLT Total Test Score, CLT Verbal Reasoning, CLT Grammar/Writing, CLT Quantitative Reasoning, or CLT Verbal Reasoning + Grammar/Writing then a test score for all 5 CLT Test Codes must be present.

These changes to the collection were approved at the March 2026, Academic Data Governance Committee meeting.

ITS will send out official communication regarding these changes and associated validations closer to the Fall 2026 EOT collection. Institutions are also encouraged to sign up for beta testing with ITS prior to the opening of the Fall 2026 EOT collection.
