



Undergraduate Admit Type, Student Type, and Student Level Edits for Dual Enrollment Codes for the Fall 2026 End-of-Term Collection

Beginning with the Fall 2026 End-of-Term (EOT) 20272 Academic Data Collection, Data Element Dictionary (DED) changes will be made to the Undergraduate Admit Type, Student Type, and Student Level data elements for dual enrollment valid value and descriptions. Changes are outlined below.

Undergraduate Admit Types (STE009)

MR - Move on When Ready – *This valid value was added 20112 but removed 20184. It will now be removed from the valid value list in the DED.*

DE - Dual Enrollment (in a program sponsored by the Georgia Department of Education and funded by Accel, where a high school student takes a course for credit that counts toward completion of high school requirements and that earns college credit). *This valid value was removed in 20162. It will now be removed from the valid value list in the DED.*

Student Type (STE080)

J - Joint Enrollment - *This valid value was removed in 20162. It will now be removed from the valid value list in the DED.*

Student Level (STE078)

11 - Joint Enrollment: Student who is jointly enrolled in high school and college. This category also includes students enrolled through Dual Enrollment programs sponsored by Georgia Department of Education Schools and paid for by Accel.

The description will be updated in the DED to the following: Dual/Joint enrollment: Student who is enrolled in college while enrolled in high school.

ITS will send out official communication regarding these changes closer to the Fall 2026 EOT collection. Institutions are also encouraged to sign up for beta testing with ITS prior to the opening of the Fall 2026 EOT collection.
